ABSTRACT

The EU-funded I-CARE4OLD project aims to individualise healthcare for the ever growing group of older persons with chronic complex conditions.

From 2021-2025, an international, multidisciplinary team of experts in healthcare, health statistics and artificial intelligence are combining their specific insights; working with big, real world data acquired for over 30 years to develop a state-of-the art digital platform providing decision support for healthcare professionals treating this particular complex group of persons. The developed solution is expected to lead to improved treatments, enhancing the quality of life of older persons with chronic complex conditions and their relatives, the quality of care, and to reduce the costs of care for society as a whole.
